This training program was designed to introduce angel investors, who are already familiar with the process of investing, to opportunities available within the water technology industry.

A BRIEF BACKGROUND

The Water Council, in conjunction with the [Angel Resource Institute](#) (ARI), has created a 4-hour training program to introduce angel investors and angel groups to water technology investment opportunities. This unique program was first delivered at WEFTEC in September of 2015.

During the session, angels will learn about:

- the broad water technology industry

- trends in investing in water technology
- unique challenges to the water technology industry

Each session includes a panel of early stage water technology CEOs who will discuss their companies and how they have secured investment. The program cost is \$3500, plus instructor travel expenses.
