Furthermore, a presentation about process optimization and the future of "the waterless slaughterhouse and dairy plant" will be given by Anette Christiansen from the Danish Agriculture & Food Council.

The seminar will conclude with advising engineers providing inputs for water optimization, and a roundtable discussion on problems, challenges and solutions within water and the food processing industry.
