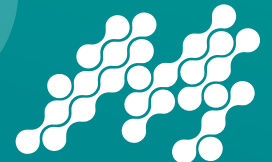

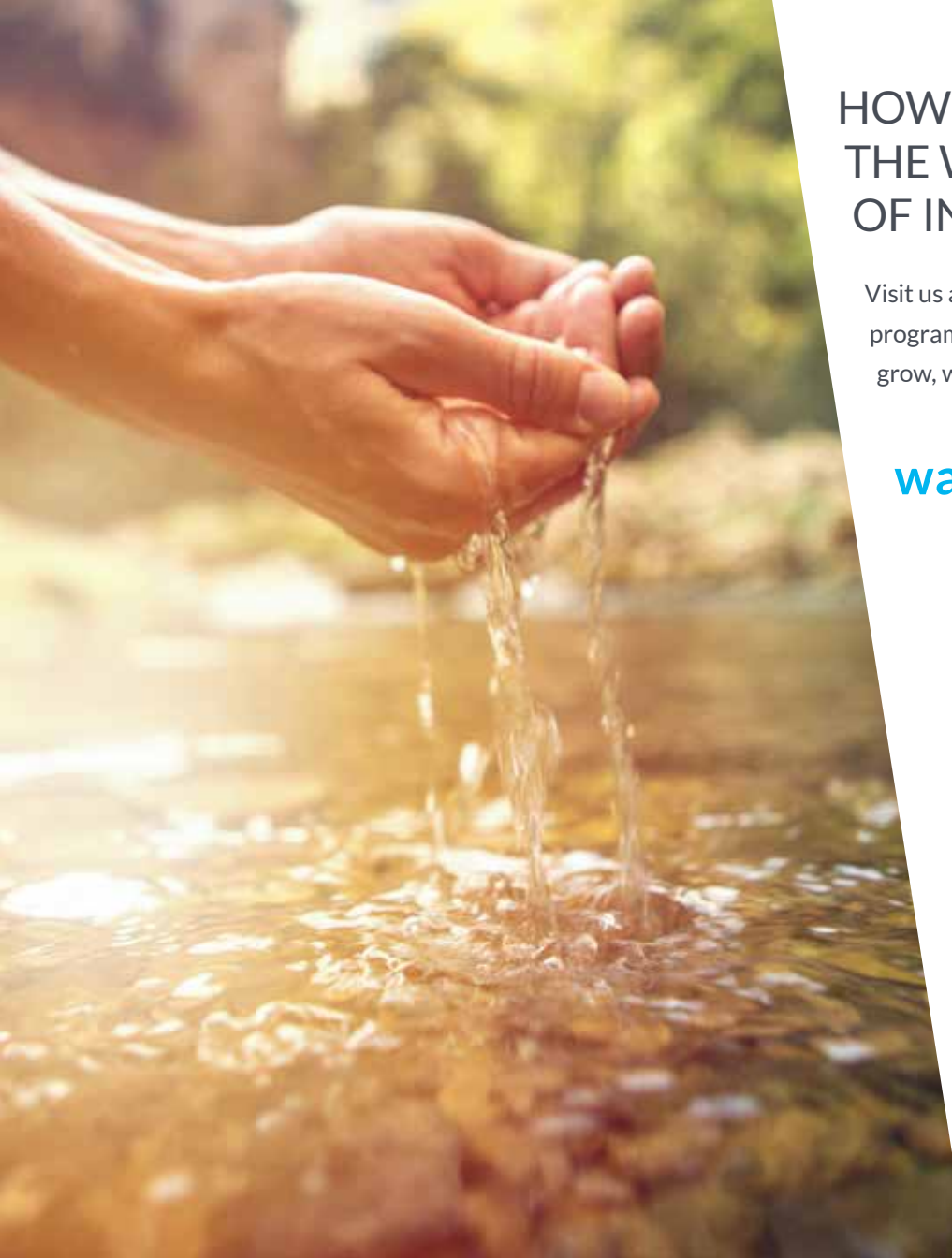
IS YOUR TECHNOLOGY READY FOR REAL-WORLD APPLICATION?
